# **Speakers**

### **Keynote Speaker: Philip Gulley**

Philip Gulley is a Quaker pastor and writer and speaker from Danville, Indiana where he lives today with his wife, Joan, and two dogs, Ruby and Jack.

An eclectic writer, Gulley has now published 21 books, including the acclaimed *Harmony* series and the new *Hope* series. Gulley's memoir, *I Love You, Miss Huddleston: And Other Inappropriate Longings of My Indiana Childhood,* recounts his coming-of-age years in Danville, Indiana. It was recognized as an Indiana Book of the Year, and was a semi-finalist for the James Thurber Prize for American Humor.

Gulley has also written several books of theology. He is currently working on his 22nd book entitled *Unlearning God*, in which he describes the process of spiritual growth, especially the re-interpretation of the earliest principles we learned about God.

Gulley has served as a Quaker pastor for 30 years, currently pastoring Fairfield Friends Meeting in Camby, Indiana. Additionally, he hosted the television program *Porch Talk with Phil Gulley* on the Indiana PBS affiliate WFYI and their flagship show *Across Indiana*, for which he received two Emmy® Awards. He also writes the popular monthly *Home Again* column for *Indianapolis Monthly* and is a regular contributor to *The Saturday Evening Post*.
