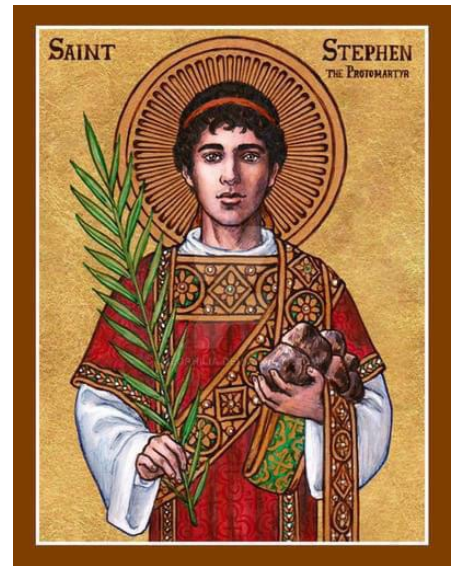


Are You being called to be a Permanent Deacon?

All four events will be 6:30 – 8:30 p.m. Canon law indicates that men must have reached the age of 35 by their ordination. In the Archdiocese of Indianapolis, we invite men to enter formation who will be no older than 65 years when they are ordained. Formation is a five-year process. Wives are welcome and encouraged to attend the “Come and See” event as well. These events are not required but could be helpful in the discernment process.
