Students work in various corporate and business settings including law and accounting firms, banks, hospitals, universities, and with other professional organizations.

We are co-educational and support our students in mind, body, and spirit. Our aspiration is that all our students graduate from high school and college and become the future leaders in our churches, institutions, businesses, nonprofits, and the community at large.
